

Griha Pravesha dates for 2020 for Moving into a New House



Below are the Shukla Paksha (bright/waxing phase of the moon) Vedic days to move into a new house in 2020. While many websites give a few dates we should be practical in this day in age about when one can move into one's new home. As far as possible try not to move in when it's the Dark phase of the moon which are the dates not given below... But of course if this is not possible then scriptures state doing things according to deshaa-kaala-artha-tattva-jnah "according to time, place and circumstances" {Srimad Bhagavatam 10.11.22} and this is what I'm trying to relay in this article.

January:- 1st to 10th and 25th to 31st

February:- 1st to 9th and 24th to 29th

March:- 1st to 9th and 25th to 31st

April:- 1st to 7th and 23rd to 30th

May:- 1st to 7th and 23rd to 31st

June:- 1st to 5th and 22nd to 30th

July:- 1st to 4th and 21st to 31st

August:- 1st to 3rd and 19th to 31st

September:- 1st to 2nd

Pitr Paksha is from (3rd to 17th - so one should NOT move into a new home in this period).

Adhik Maas is from (18th to 30th - so one should NOT move into a new home in this period).

October:- 17th to 31st

Adhik Maas is from (1st to 16th - so one should NOT move into a new home in this period).


November:- 16th to 30th

December:- 16th to 30th
